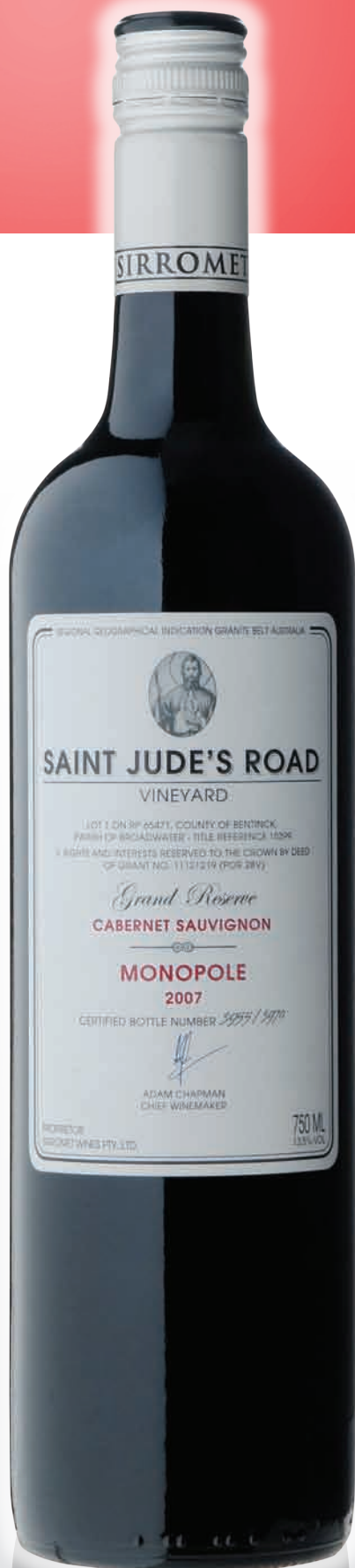

Category:	Red
Variety:	Cabernet Sauvignon
Region:	Granite Belt
Colour:	Black cherry with violet hues
Cellaring:	Drink now – 2015
Nose:	Cassis, raspberries, violets and soft vanillin notes.
Palate:	Perfumed, rich, voluptuous Cabernet Sauvignon showing elegant yet intense varietal characters of cassis, chocolate, soft herbal notes with touches of vanilla.
Winemaking Comments:	Once in a while Winemakers find specific parcels of superior fruit that is unique to the regions terroir. In 2007 Adam Chapman, Sirromet's Chief Winemaker, found such a parcel. As a result we believe this to be Sirromet's best ever Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon from an excellent vintage on the Granite Belt.
